

# 2020 Ladies Only Vegas Qualifier Tournament Format

In order to ensure that everyone gets in on the fun and a little table time action, we are going to start out by playing a Toledo Style Round Robin Event. Instead of using a blind draw to determine the brackets, we will use the standings after the Round Robin Rounds to determine the brackets.

## Round Robin Guidelines

- Each team will play each other once
- Each round will consist of 3 members from each team playing 1 rack for 1 point.
- Each round teams will set their lineup with the 3 players chosen to play and then exchange it with each other. Once the lineups are set for the Round Robin they cannot be changed unless it violates the 13 rule.
- There are no timeouts during the Round Robin Rounds.
- Max Skill Level for the 3 members playing cannot exceed 13.
- Each member of the team must play at least 2 times during the Round Robin.
- Teams who are not on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Match within 45 Minutes during the Round Robin Rounds will forfeit the 3<sup>rd</sup> match for the round and receive 0 points for that individual match and any other matches that have not yet started.
- All Round Robin Rounds will start at the same time.
- Teams who have players who do not play a minimum of 2 matches during the Round Robin will have a 1/2 point per round deducted from their teams point total at the end of Round Robin play.

At the conclusion of the Round Robin, we will tally the points and rank the teams & bracket accordingly. We will then run a Modified Single or Double Elimination winner take all Tournament following the **Ladies Only Vegas Tournament Guidelines**. The Rosters & Ladies Only Tournament Guidelines are attached below. Good Luck to all the ladies competing in 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Ladies Only Vegas Qualifier. If you have any questions. - **If we are running behind time we may have to split tables during match play. As a reminder a player cannot call a timeout and coach a player while shooting their own match on the other table.**
